Synuclein-α (E123) Peptide

Background

The synuclein family members, including α -synuclein (also designated NACP for non- β amyloid component) and β -synuclein, are predominantly expressed in the brain and are speculated to be involved in synaptic regulation and neuronal plasticity. α -synuclein is localized to neuronal cell bodies and synapses. α -synuclein was first identified as a component of Alzheimer's disease amyloid plaques. Abnormal platelet function in Alzheimer's disease has been demonstrated. During megakaryocytic differentiation α -synuclein was found to be up-regulated, while β -synuclein is down-regulated, indicating that coordinate expression of synucleins may be important during hematopoetic cell differentiation. A mutant form of α -synuclein has been found in patients with early onset Parkinson's disease.
