

**OPLAH polyclonal antibody**

**BackGround:**

The protein encoded by this gene acts as a homodimer, using ATP hydrolysis to catalyze the conversion of 5-oxo-L-proline to L-glutamate. Defects in this gene are a cause of 5-oxoprolinase deficiency (OPLAHD).

**Product:**

1mg/ml in PBS with 0.02% sodium azide, 50% glycerol, pH7.2

**Purification&Purity:**

The antibody was affinity-purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity-chromatography using epitope-specific immunogen and the purity is > 95% (by SDS-PAGE).

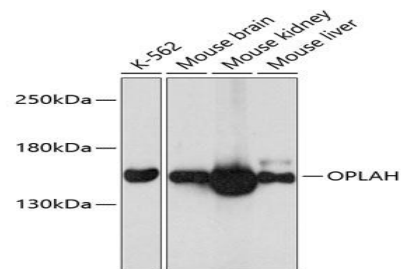
**Storage&Stability:**

Store at 4 °C short term. Aliquot and store at -20 °C long

term. Avoid freeze-thaw cycles.

**DATA:**

Western blot analysis of extracts of various cell lines, using OPLAH antibody at 1:3000 dilution. Secondary antibody: HRP Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG at 1:10000 dilution. Lysates/proteins: 25ug per lane. Blocking buffer: 3% nonfat dry milk in TBST. Detection: ECL Basic Kit. Exposure time: 1s.
