

ASNS polyclonal antibody

BackGround:

The protein encoded by this gene is involved in the synthesis of asparagine. This gene complements a mutation in the temperature-sensitive hamster mutant ts11, which blocks progression through the G1 phase of the cell cycle at nonpermissive temperature. Alternatively spliced transcript variants have been described for this gene.

1mg/ml in PBS with 0.02% sodium azide, 50% glycerol, pH7.2

Purification&Purity:

The antibody was affinity-purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity-chromatography using epitope-specific immunogen and the purity is > 95% (by SDS-PAGE).

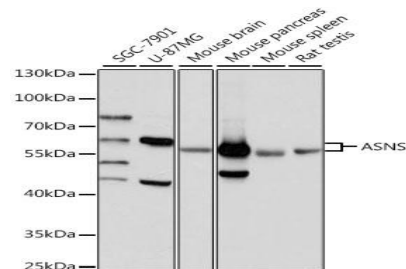

Storage&Stability:

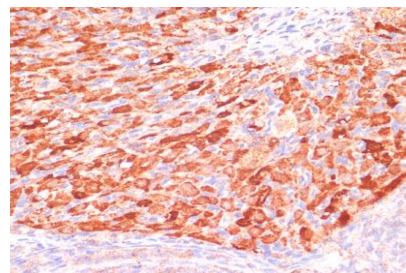
Store at 4 °C short term. Aliquot and store at -20 °C long term. Avoid freeze-thaw cycles.

Modification:

DATA:

Western blot analysis of extracts of various cell lines, using ASNS antibody at 1:1000 dilution. Secondary antibody: HRP Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG at 1:10000 dilution. Lysates/proteins: 25ug per lane. Blocking buffer: 3% nonfat dry milk in TBST. Detection: ECL Basic Kit. Exposure time: 3s.



Immunohistochemistry of paraffin-embedded rat ovary using ASNS antibody at dilution of 1:100. Perform microwave antigen retrieval with 10 mM PBS buffer pH 7.2 before commencing with IHC staining protocol.
